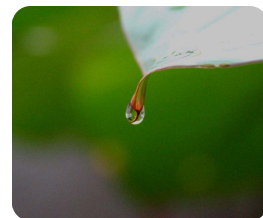

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Mad Hatters

The Vaccine Industry, CDC, AMA, and FDA continually defends mercury as “safe.”

“It’s not that bad, really. What’s a little mercury in your shot anyway? Ignore these inconvenient facts: A typical flu vaccine shot solution is 50,000 parts per billion of mercury. The EPA classifies any substance with more than 200 parts per billion as hazardous waste. (The EPA limit in drinking water is 2 parts per billion.) Thus, the mercury density in a vaccine is 25,000% higher than the level required to be considered hazardous waste. This is injected directly into the bloodstream of infants, children, expectant mothers and senior citizens. What could possibly be dangerous about that?”

Mercury is the most toxic element second only to radioactive Plutonium. Danbury, Connecticut, was the hat making capital of the world in the 19th century. There, mercury nitrate was used to remove fur from pelts to make into felt. Hat makers, exposed to large amounts of vaporized mercury, began to experience its effects on their nervous systems making them appear to be insane. In the early 1940s the state of Connecticut outlawed mercury use in hat making but mercury remains in the soil and river sediment not far from where the factories once stood. Currently a wide variety of products contain mercury including cosmetics, dental fillings, fabric softeners, batteries, inks used by printers and tattooists, latex, some medications, some paints, plastics, polishes, solvents, wood preservatives, fungicides, and pesticides. Some grains and seeds are treated with methyl mercury chlorine bleaches which seep into the food supply. An estimated 1/3 of American lakes and 1/4 of American rivers are contaminated with mercury with large amounts found in fish.

Small enough to pass through the blood brain barrier, Mercury injures brain cells and is retained in the central nervous system. Its presence can prevent both the entry of nutrients and removal of wastes of the cells. It can bind with immune cells, distorting them and interfering with normal immune responses - perhaps a factor of autoimmune disorders. Mercury can cause permanent kidney, cardiac and respiratory disorders. Significant amounts in the body can cause asthma, arthritis, depression, dermatitis, dizziness, fatigue, gum disease, metallic taste, nausea, “hatter’s shakes” (similar to Parkinson’s), vomiting, hair loss, insomnia, headaches, joint pain, slurred speech, memory loss, diarrhea, muscle weakness, excessive salivation. Toxic levels in children can cause peeling of the skin, blindness, increased heart rate, agitation, and pain in the arms and legs. Mercury in pregnancy can cause neurological damage to infants - lower intelligence, delayed development and high mortality rates. “Mad Hatter” behaviors include depression, confusion, irritability, hyperactivity, aggressiveness, mood-swings, antisocial conduct.

To remove heavy metals from the body - The B.E.S.T foot bath; or Glutathione plus L-methionine and L-cysteine with Selenium, Vitamin E, apple pectin, Vitamin C with bioflavonoids; cilantro. Essential oils are natural chelators, binding with heavy metals and petrochemicals and ferrying them out of the body. Helichrysum, celery seed and ledum essential oils in a blend (Juva Cleanse) dramatically amplify the elimination of heavy metals, especially mercury.
